WHY A SANCTUARY MATTERS

A new sanctuary will be a tremendous blessing for Nacoochee Methodist Church. It will provide the space we need for worship, as well as for important gatherings such as Vacation Bible School, age-level Bible studies, and

EAGLE outreach events.

But above all, the primary purpose of a sanctuary is the worship and praise of God.

It is in worship that we meet God, connect with God, and are transformed as we hear the Word and lift our voices in song,

liturgy, and prayer. The building is a place, not an idol—a space where we worship God, have fellowship with one another, and support each other in times of need.

Updated audio-visual technology will further enhance our worship experience and make online streaming more effective, allowing us to reach beyond our walls and minister to those who cannot be physically present.

DID YOU KNOW?

Our new sanctuary will be a regional technology hub for ministry. With three professional-grade cameras, a 64-channel audio mixer, and dedicated streaming equipment, we

will be able to share worship services, Bible studies, and special events online with broadcast-quality production.



This means college students, deployed military members, homebound saints, potential guests, and all those who happen upon our site can all experience Nacoochee Methodist worship from anywhere in the world.

OUR GOAL: DEBT-FREE

We are raising funds so that we can enter the new sanctuary without the burden of debt—freeing future generations to focus on ministry and mission rather than mortgage payments.

WHAT IS A FAITH PROMISE?

In Jeremiah 29:11-14, two verses are key—verses 12 and 13:

When you call me and come and pray to me, I will listen to you. When you search for me, yes, search for me with all your heart, you will find me.



GOD'S PROMISE

A Faith Promise is different from a pledge. It is built on trust in God's promise. We pray, asking the Lord to show us what to give. You make a Faith Promise based on what God is leading you to give—not based solely on what is in your bank account today, but on faith that God will provide.

Your name is not required on the card. You make a promise based on your faith in God. You have faith that God will provide you with the means to give what He has laid on your heart.
